Dear Sir or Madam:

This correspondence will serve as my letter of recommendation for Pro-Mark Services, Inc. I have worked directly with Pro-Mark Services, Inc. on the construction of the new Farm Credit Services Building located in Bottineau, ND since May 2012. This newly constructed office building with attached lease space and detached garage is a two-story building consisting of 7,050 square feet. The facility is a wood framed, brick clad structure utilizing slab-on-grade floor, wood truss roof, aluminum windows and 24 gauge standing seam metal roof system.

Pro-Mark Services, Inc. has exceeded my expectations during the construction of this facility. Very few questions and/or concerns arose during the work and any that did arise were answered and/or taken care of with due diligence by Pro-Mark Services. Pro-Mark Services provides excellent communication, knowledgeable staff including Project Manager, Superintendent and all subcontractors and overall exemplary workmanship.

In addition to the work on the Farm Credit Services facility, I am working with Pro-Mark Services on the Classroom Addition for the St. John, ND School District #3. This project is being performed in two phases, the first of which includes a new 12,000 square foot seven classroom addition to the existing school. This addition is a single-story, slab-on-grade, wood and steel-framed structure, with the exterior walls being metal stud framed. The second phase consists of remodeling the existing 8,650 square foot gymnasium including selective demolition, additional wood athletic flooring and gymnasium seating and installation of an automatic fire-sprinkling system. This project has also been performed in a professional, workmanlike manner with any issues that have arisen being resolved effectively and cost efficiently by Pro-Mark Services.

EAPC has also teamed with Pro-Mark Services, Inc. on the current \$48 million MATOC contract with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Omaha District as its design engineering firm for all design-build projects advertised under the contract. We are currently at the 90% design phase for the Security Forces Quarters Renovation project at Building 720A at the Cavalier Air Force Station, which is delivery order 0004 under the main MATOC contract. The total delivery



order value of \$2,530,000 includes both design and construction costs associated with the tear off and installation of a new roof on the security forces building.

EAPC has worked with Pro-Mark Services, Inc. on several other government and non-government commercial construction projects within the last three years and I would not hesitate to enter into a contract with Pro-Mark Services in the future, nor would I give pause to recommending Pro-Mark Services to a client in search of a general contractor that displays integrity and pride in their work.
